- During the times when the teens are returning from a trip, please leave your cell phones on or let your teen know what phone number you'll be at. You will then be contacted by your teen or by the automated system if the buses will be very early or very late. If you know you will not be on time, please call Joe at **917 826-4351** or Danielle at **631 848-7336**.
- If the parent cannot be there on time at the late pick-ups at Melville Bowl, teens will be held for 15 minutes. At that point, they will be brought to Crestwood. Once you realize that you will be more than 15 minutes late, call the Teen Director or your teen and go directly to Crestwood.
- **On Friday, July 1**, teens will have their meetings to discuss the trip to Baltimore. Remember that all teens go on these trips. Make every effort to make sure your teen comes to Crestwood on that day. Teens will get a copy of the Fact Sheet for the trip (it was the same one given out at the orientation) and it will also be posted on the website.
- If you need to write a note to the teen staff, or have papers to hand in to the directors, give them to your teen to give directly to the program director. If the letter is given to the bus driver, there is a good chance that we will already have left the grounds for our trip before the director gets the note (basically defeating the purpose of the note).
- **It is imperative that your teen check in for attendance before he/she does anything else every day.**
