Weather permitting, the pools will be open, activities such as zipline, tennis, arts and crafts, nature, climbing tower, mini golf, and electric jeeps for the younger children are here for you to enjoy. (Plus many more fun activities.) On this special day, group assignments will be given and you can set up your child's cubby/locker. Also all of our Administrators, Nurses, Directors and Division Heads will be available to meet you. Group Leaders for 1<sup>st</sup> grade and younger will be here to meet you and your child(ren).

**Please, please label all clothing and equipment** in a conspicuous place to prevent loss. We recommend using either an indelible marker or sewn in labels. This recommendation also applies to clothing worn by the child when he/she leaves home each day. Also, avoid dressing your child(ren) in new clothing. Use only expendable items. Crestwood will provide all sports and activity equipment.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade and Older: Individual Lockers:**

All boys and girls 4<sup>th</sup> grade and older will have individual lockers assigned. Please bring in a combination lock (locks with keys are not permitted) on clothing day if you would like to safeguard belongings.

**Special Events:**

Our tentative Special Events Calendar for the 2010 summer is enclosed. In addition to all the fun activities regularly scheduled for your sons and daughters, these events and many other surprises will add to their excitement. Pre-School and Kindergarten parents, please note groups are not yet finalized (when looking at visiting days and shows).

**Lunch Menu & Sub Form:**

Our 2010 July Menu and Substitution form is enclosed. Please discuss the meals with your child and try to encourage them to expand their culinary interests. If your child will not eat a particular item, please cross it out on the sub form and write in what they would prefer to eat. Please note that any child will be able to receive a substitute if they try and do not like their original choice.
