Crestwood's policy of hiring the most mature staff for its children leaves many teens who have been part of our renowned recreational programs wondering how they can be a part of Crestwood if they are not quite old enough to be a counselor. Our Apprentice Program offers an exceptional program for these young adults.

With each year in our program, Crestwood Apprentices will develop new skills that will help them in their growth and maturity. It is our goal to give your Teens the experience they need to be successful, not just at Crestwood, but wherever and whenever new leadership, work or school opportunities come their way. Teens will accomplish all this, while being under the trained supervision of Crestwood staff, having fun, meeting new friends, and making camp memories that will last a lifetime.

All Apprentice Programs include Lunch and Door-to-Door Transportation

Typical Day for a Crestwood Apprentice:

- Work Experience with Campers at Activity Areas by interest and availability
- 1-2 Hours for Lunch, Break, Group Activity, Class Time and/or Training Sessions

Entering 10th, 11th, 12th Grade Program

- Tuition: \$2,000 for 8 week summer program
